ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN BILINGUAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Admissions Requirements

1. B.A./B.S. degree from an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 3.00. (An applicant with less than a 3.00 undergraduate average may be admitted as a limited matriculant.)
2. Two professional letters of recommendation
3. A written statement of professional goals
